Call for applications

Art, the City, and Democracy <u>Artists residence at Villa Waldberta with an emphasis on a theme (One position)</u>

Period: 04 May to 29 July 2021

Application deadline: 15 December 2020

The City of Munich and their program ARTIST IN RESIDENCE MUNICH with its two residences Villa Waldberta and Ebenböckhaus stand for openness, encounters, and exchanges between people from all over the world. Considering the background of Germany's and Munich's history in the 20th century, and due to the current anti-democratic developments worldwide, with this call for applications we would like to initiate a discussion on how we can create, maintain, and continue to develop an open and democratic society, and what role cities and artists can play in this.

Who can apply?

Professional artists of all genres and scientists from art-related fields who reside outside of the State of Bavaria may apply.

We welcome applications from persons of all nationalities, religions, sexual identities, age groups, and social backgrounds. We also look forward to receive applications from persons with disabilities; as Villa Waldberta is not barrier-free, if need be we would request that you contact us in advance in order to clarify the availability of the necessary infrastructure, and, when required, to find individual, tailored solutions.

We offer:

- Reimbursement of travel costs (economy class) up to € 350.00 within Europe, and up to € 800.00 if you travel from outside Europe to Munich
- One rent-free apartment per person with its own kitchen and bathroom at Villa Waldberta.
- A monthly grant of € 1,200.00 per person
- A studio, and the availability of an exhibition space (the "Palmenhaus" the Palm House)
- Events on the theme open to the public

We expect:

- A good working knowledge of spoken and written English.
- The willingness to work together with the ARTIST IN RESIDENCE MUNICH team, and with our partners in the art and cultural fields in Munich.
- The willingness to participate in events open to the general public.

We require the following documents in German or English (as a PDF file, exclusively):

- Artist's statement on the theme " Art, the City, and Democracy"
- Your curriculum vitae
- Your portfolio / organized image material, text samples, or radio play samples, etc.

Selection process

The selection will be made by a committee of representatives from the Department of Arts and Culture. If deemed necessary, external experts or cooperation partners in Munich will be consulted. We will inform you by January 31, 2021 concerning whether or not your application has been accepted.

Depending upon the course of the Covid-19 pandemic, we reserve the right to make changes to the residency, including the right to cancel the residency.
